The Vision of the Riches of Christ

I. The unsearchable riches of Christ as the gospel

Colossians 1:12 Giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you for a share of the allotted portion of the saints in the light.

Ephesians 3:8 To me, less than the least of all saints, was this grace given to announce to the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ as the gospel.

Ephesians 1:17 That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you a spirit of wisdom and revelation in the full knowledge of Him, **18a** The eyes of your heart having been enlightened.

3:14 For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father.... **16** That He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit into the inner man, **17** That Christ may make His home in your hearts through faith.

II. The riches of Christ in the Gospel of John

A. God

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

14:9 Jesus said to him, Have I been so long a time with you, and you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; how *is it that* you say, Show us the Father?

20:28 Thomas answered and said to Him, My Lord and my God!

B. The Word, flesh, and the tabernacle

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. **14** And the Word became flesh and tabernacled among us (and we beheld His glory, glory as of the only Begotten from the Father), full of grace and reality.

18 No one has ever seen God; the only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared *Him.*

1 John 1:1 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we beheld and our hands handled, concerning the Word of life.

C. Life and light

John 1:4 In Him was life, and the life was the light of men.

D. The Lamb

John 1:29 The next day he saw Jesus coming to him and said, Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!

E. The Spirit

John 1:32 And John testified, saying, I beheld the Spirit descending as a dove out of heaven, and He abode upon Him.

1 Corinthians **15:45** So also it is written, "The first man, Adam, became a living soul"; the last Adam *became* a lifegiving Spirit. (*Cf.* **2** Corinthians **3:17**, "the Lord is the Spirit," **18** "the Lord Spirit"; **4:5** "Christ Jesus as Lord")

F. The house and the heavenly ladder

John 1:42 He led him to Jesus. Looking at him, Jesus said, You are Simon, the son of John; you shall be called Cephas (which is interpreted, Peter).

51 And He said to him, Truly, truly, I say to you, You shall see heaven opened and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man.

G. The temple

John 2:19 Jesus answered and said to them, Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.... **21** But He spoke of the temple of His body.

H. The bronze serpent

John 3:14 And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up.

I. The eternal life

John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that everyone who believes into Him would not perish, but would have eternal life.

J. The bride

John 3:29 He who has the bride is the bridegroom... 30 He must increase, but I *must* decrease.

K. The spring

John 4:14 But whoever drinks of the water that I will give him shall by no means thirst forever; but the water that I will give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into eternal life.

24 God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truthfulness.

L. The Feast of the Passover and the Feast of Tabernacles

John 6:4 Now the Passover, the feast of the Jews, was near.

54 He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up in the last day.

57 As the living Father has sent Me and I live because of the Father, so he who eats Me, he also shall live because of Me.

63 It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing; the words which I have spoken to you are spirit and are life.

7:2 Now the Jews' Feast of Tabernacles was near.

37 Now on the last day, the great *day* of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. **38** He who believes into Me, as the Scripture said, out of his innermost being shall flow rivers of living water. **39** But this He said concerning the Spirit, whom those who believed into Him were about to receive; for *the* Spirit was not yet, because Jesus had not yet been glorified.

M. The Shepherd, the door, the pasture, and the flock

John 10:9 I am the door; if anyone enters through Me, he shall be saved and shall go in and go out and shall find pasture.

11 I am the good Shepherd; the good Shepherd lays down His life for the sheep.

16 And I have other sheep, which are not of this fold; I must lead them also, and they shall hear My voice, and there shall be one flock, one Shepherd.

N. The resurrection and the life

John 11:25 Jesus said to her, I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes into Me, even if he should die, shall live.

O. The grain of wheat

John 12:24 Truly, truly, I say to you, Unless the grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it abides alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit.

P. The way, the reality, and the life

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, I am the way and the reality and the life; no one comes to the Father except through Me.

Q. The Comforter

John 14:16-17 And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Comforter, that He may be with you forever, *even* the Spirit of reality, whom the world cannot receive, because it does not behold Him or know *Him; but* you know Him, because He abides with you and shall be in you.

R. The all-inclusive consummated Spirit

John 20:22 And when He had said this, He breathed into them and said to them, Receive the Holy Spirit.
